There are two ways to access our site:

From a Library Computer:

Visit your library's Web site or check the library computers' desktops for a link to our database. Alternatively, ask your reference librarian where to locate our online resources.

From Home:

To access us from outside the library, check your library's Web site for the link to our site or contact your reference librarian. If further authorization is required, you will be prompted for the following:



WHAT INFORMATION WILL I FIND?

- **History:** thousands of historical maps, fact sheets, images, and timelines that cover the entire span of U.S. and world history
- **Government:** handouts on various governing bodies around the world, including their structure and function
- **Religion:** handouts on various religious faiths, leaders, rituals, and festivals
- **Geography:** large selection of printable maps—including geographical, historical, and statistical maps
- **Science Diagrams:** thousands of printable diagrams, many in full color
- **Science Experiments:** hands-on activities for science education in subjects such as biology, chemistry, Earth science, physics, weather, and space
- **Mathematics:** problem sets ranging from simple to advanced levels, arranged by subject—algebra, geometry, and calculus
- **Physical Education and Health:** handouts organized by topic—from diet and mental health to sports rules
- **My Folders:** a unique, easy-to-manage feature that allows users to create password-protected folders to which individual handouts can be saved.

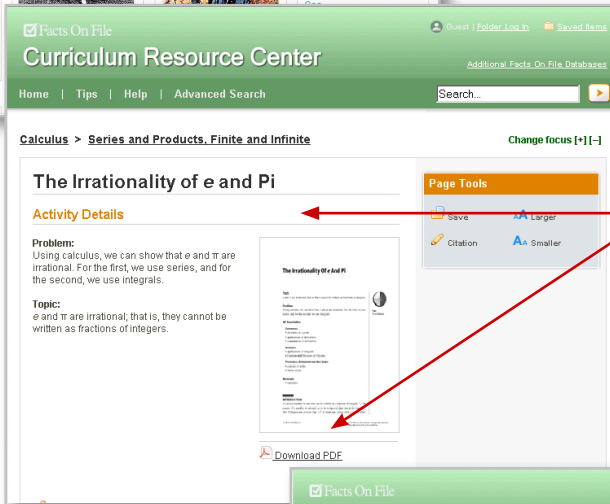

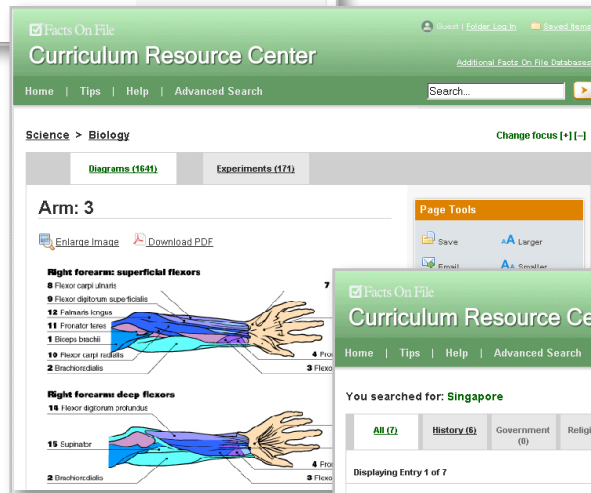

Preview the “**Activity Details**” of math problem sets before clicking on the “**Download PDF**” icon and distributing for educational purposes.

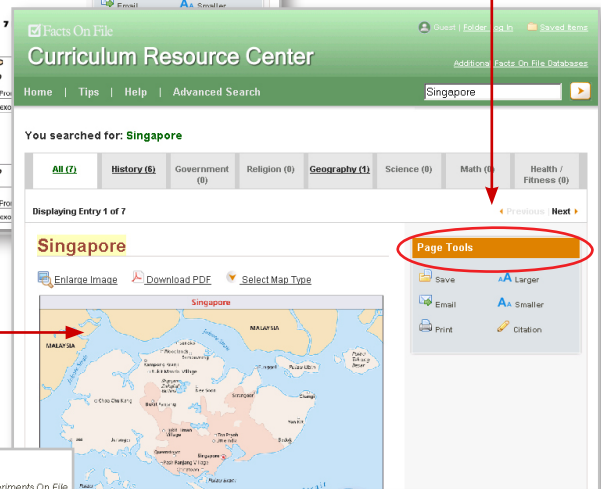


Use **printable diagrams** to further explore key principles in science.
