

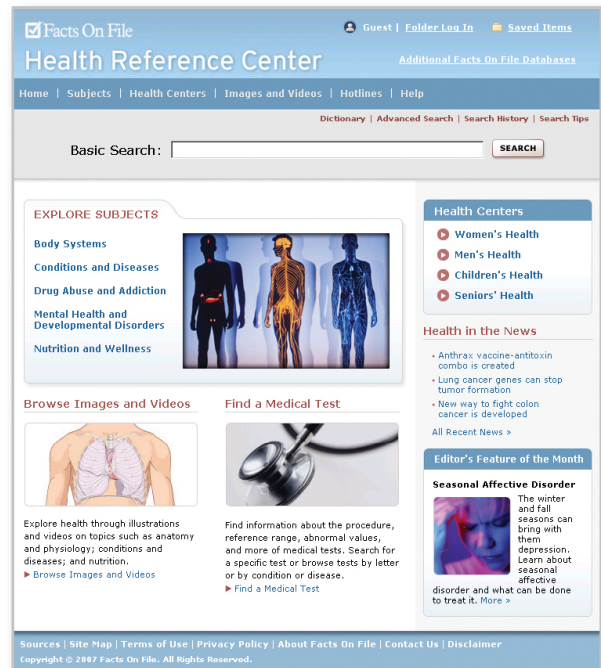

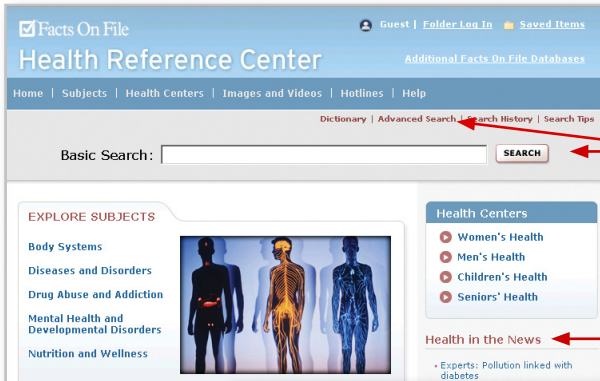
WHAT INFORMATION WILL I FIND?

 - * Hotlines listings.

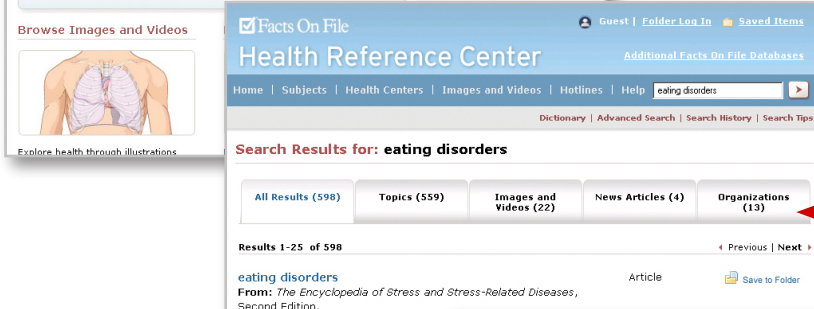

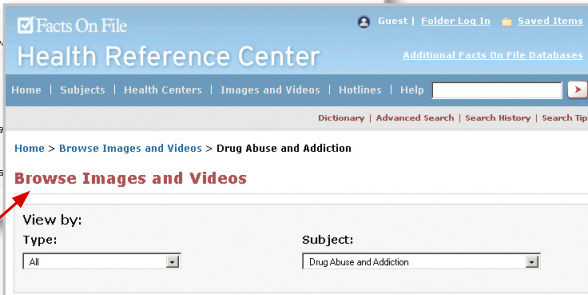
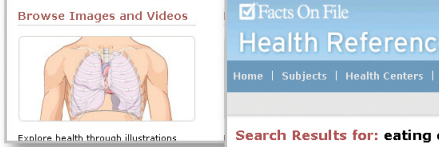


A **search tool** appears on every page. Alternatively, click on **“Advanced Search”** to broaden or narrow your search.



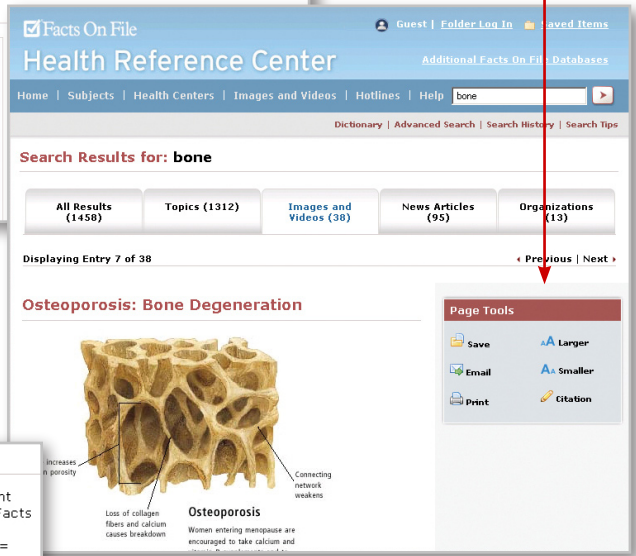
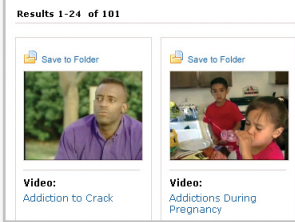
The **“Health in the News”** section is searchable and browsable.
