Unique Learning Centers pull forward handpicked entries within each major era and North American culture area. The "Tribes and Culture Areas" section is easy to browse with a helpful tabbed list of tribes, representing more than 600 Native American groups, and a browse-by-culture-area feature. Each Learning Center and each record have a persistent record link. Users can search by keyword or phrase and can browse by topic, tribe, culture area, and time period. In addition, Biographies can be browsed by occupation, and Primary Sources by type. Full citations are available throughout, and users can print, copy, and save content to a folder.
